



NOTICE OF RACE
International German Youth Championship of the Europe class
from 30.05.2019 to 02.06.2019

Organizing Authority: German Sailing Federation
Host club: 1. Segelclub Partwitzer See (SC-003)

1. RULES

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS).
- 1.2 In all rules governing this regatta:
[NP] denotes a rule that shall not be grounds for protests by a boat. This changes RRS 60.1(a).
- 1.3 RRS Appendix P, special procedures for rule 42, will apply.
- 1.4 If there is a conflict between languages the English text will take precedence. For the national prescriptions of the German Sailing Federation (DSV), the notice of race and the sailing instructions the German text will take precedence.

2. [DP] ADVERTISING

- 2.1 Boats may be required to display advertising and bow numbers chosen and supplied by the organizing authority.
- 2.2 Advertising for alcohol or tobacco products in direct or indirect form on the boat and on the person is prohibited.

3. [NP] [DP] ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 3.1 The regatta is open to boats of the class as follows: Europe
- 3.2 Eligible are:
Sailors born in 2000 or later.
 - 3.2.1 Sailors who are member of a club affiliated to DSV shall qualify with one of the following preconditions:
 - 3.2.1.1 Helmsman listed in the current German ranking list of the class with at least 25 points and at least 9 ranking list scores.
 - 3.2.2 Sailors who are members of a club affiliated to other national authorities of World Sailing in order of the date of entry.

- 3.3 The person in charge shall provide either a valid licence of DSV, „Jüngstensegelschein“, „Sportsegelschein“ or a valid official licence prescribed or recommended for the racing area. Members of other national associations shall provide an equivalent licence issued by their national authority.
- 3.4 Each competitor shall be a member of a club affiliated to his national authority of World Sailing.
- 3.5 Each sailor who is a member of a club affiliated to DSV shall have registered on the website of DSV.
- 3.6 Eligible boats shall enter by completing the online entry form on the website www.manage2sail.com until **14.05.2019** and paying the required fees.

4. CLASSIFICATION

5. FEES

- 5.1 Required fees are as follows:

- 5.2 The entry fee shall be paid to the bank account of 1.Segelclub Partwitzer See e.V at Ostsächsische Sparkasse Dresden, BIC: OSDDDE81XXX, IBAN: DE50 8505 0300 3000 1309 25 naming the regatta, the name of the helmsman/helmswoman and the sail number.
- 5.3 The entry fee shall be paid upon entering, even if the entry is cancelled later or the boat does not show up. The entry fee is non-refundable, except for the regatta or class being cancelled by the organizing authority or if the entry is rejected.

6. SCHEDULE

- 6.1 Registration for competitors, coaches and team leaders is scheduled as follows:

- 6.2 On the first scheduled racing day a skippers meeting will be held at 11:30 hrs. Details will be published in the Sailing Instructions.
- 6.3 The schedule of races and dates of racing is as follows:

- 6.4 On the last day of racing, no warning signal will be made after 13:00 hrs.

7. [NP] [DP] MEASUREMENTS

- 7.1 Each boat shall produce a valid measurement certificate.
- 7.2 All boats shall be measured during the measurement and inspection period as stated in NoR
- 7.3. During the scheduled time for measurement controls no initial (first) measurements will be carried out.

8. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The sailing instructions will be available at registration.

9. VENUE

- 9.1 The Events will be hosted at 02979 Elsterheide OT Klein-Partwitz, Hohe Düne 1.

- 9.2 The race office will be located on the premises of the 1. Segelclub Partwitzer See.
Directions are available on our website www.1-scp.de.
- 9.3 The racing area will be Partwitzer See.

10. COURSES

The courses will be defined in the sailing instructions.

11. SCORING

- 11.1 Four races are required to be completed to constitute a championship.
- 11.2 When fewer than five races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores. When five or more races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.
- 11.3 Applies only when a minimum of 10 boats compete in their scoring division:
The U17-division is an extract of the overall score and applies only to competitors born in 2003 or later.

12. [NP] [DP] SUPPORT BOATS

- 12.1 All support boats shall be registered with the organizing authority and will be required to comply with local legislation and event Support Team Regulations that will be published in the sailing instructions. The organizing authority may refuse registrations and accept later registrations at their sole discretion.
- 12.2 Support persons shall wear personal flotation devices at all times while afloat, except briefly while changing or adjusting clothing or personal equipment. Support persons shall use the kill cord at all times when the engine is running.
- 12.3 Support boats shall be insured with valid and for the racing area suitable third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of 3.000.000 EUR per incident or the equivalent.

13. [DP] BERTHING

Boats shall be kept in their assigned places while they are in the boat park or harbour.

14. [DP] RADIO COMMUNICATION

Except in an emergency or when using equipment provided by the organizing authority, a boat that is racing shall not make voice or data transmissions and shall not receive voice or data communication that is not available to all boats.

15. PRIZES

- 15.1 Medals will be awarded to the first three overall places and the first three of the U17 age division by DSV. The number of certificates will be published.
- 15.2 The following titles will be awarded to the winners in each class:
Internationale(r) Deutsche(r) Jugendmeister(in) of the Europe class 2019
Internationale(r) Deutsche(r) Jugendmeister(in) of the Europe class 2019 in the U17 age division
- 15.3 Prizes will be awarded to the best six overall scored boats, the best three boats of the U17 age division and the best three helmswomen.
- 15.4 Additional prizes and perpetual trophies for the individual classes will be listed in the program.
- 15.5 Prizes not claimed at the prize giving ceremony will remain with the organizing authority.

16. [DP] MEDIA RIGHTS, CAMERAS AND ELECTRONIC EQUIPMENT

- 16.1 By participating in the event competitors automatically grant to the organizing authority the right in perpetuity to make, use and show, from time to time at their discretion, any motion pictures and live, taped or filmed television and other reproductions of the athlete during the period of the competition without compensation.

- 16.2 Boats may be required to carry cameras, sound equipment and positioning equipment as specified and supplied by the organizing authority.
- 16.3 Competitors may be required to be available for interviews at the regatta.

17. LIMITATION OF LIABILITY COGNOVITS CLAUSE

- 17.1 The responsibility for the decision to participate in a race or to continue with it is solely with the skipper; to that extent the skipper also accepts full responsibility for the crew. The skipper is responsible for the qualification and the correct nautical conduct of the crew as well as for the suitability and the transport-safe-condition of the registered boat. In cases of force majeure or on grounds of administrative orders or for safety reasons, the organizer is entitled to make changes in the realization of the event or to cancel the event. This does not constitute any liability by the organizer towards the participant, if the reasons for the changes or the cancellation do not result from a willful or grossly negligent behaviour of the organizer. In case of a violation of obligations that do not constitute primary or material contractual duties (cardinal obligations), the liability of the organizer for financial and property damages incurred by the participant during or in connection with the participation in the event and resulting from a conduct of the organizer, its representatives, servants or agents, is restricted to damages that were caused willfully or grossly negligent. When a violation of cardinal obligations occurs due to minor negligence, the liability of the organizer is limited to foreseeable, typical damages. To the extent that the liability for damages of the organizer is excluded or restricted, the participant also relieves the staff - employees and representatives, agents, servants, sponsors and individuals who provide or drive salvage, safety or rescue vessels or assist with their use - from the individual liability for damages, as well as all other individuals who were instructed to act in connection with the realization of the event.
- 17.2 The effective racing rules of World Sailing, the administrative regulations regatta-sailing and the articles of association of DSV, the class rules as well as the regulations of the invitation to the competition and the sailing instructions are to be complied with and are expressly recognized.
- 17.3 The German law shall prevail.
- 17.4 Competitors shall present a signed and completed consent and declaration form at registration. For competitors under 18 years of age these forms shall be signed by a parent or guardian. 18. [DP] INSURANCE

Each participating boat shall be insured with valid (and for the racing area suitable) third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of 3.000.000 EUR per incident or the equivalent.

19. PRIVACY POLICY

The registration for the regatta takes place exclusively via the Manage2sail registration system! During the registration, different options, such as additional meals and shoe size, are queried. Please fill out these data carefully.

1. DIRECTIONS

- 1.1. Directions to the club's premises are described on the club's website at www.1-scp.de.
- 1.2. After prior agreement with the club, all sailors can park their boats even before the regatta on the shore strip below the club area.

2. RACE PROGRAM

- 2.1. After 9:00 hrs on 29.05.2019, the program can be picked up in the org. office.

3. BOARD / LODGING / ACCOMPANYING PROGRAM

- 3.1. For championship participants, the dinner on Thursday, Friday and Saturday (championship party) is included in the entry fee.
From Thursday to Sunday, we offer a breakfast buffet, which can be booked with the registration for the championship. In addition, a roll service is offered from Thursday to Sunday.
For accompanying guests, dinner and breakfast can also be booked up to the registration deadline.
After the registration deadline, additional bookings for meals will not be possible.
From Wednesday to Sunday, there is a beverage supply on site.
- 3.2. From Wednesday to Sunday, pitches for campers, caravans and tents of the championship participants are available free of charge on the club's premises. If you want to arrive earlier or leave later, you have to pay 10,00 € pitch fee per vehicle / tent per overnight stay. The payment takes place at the site.
Cars that are not used for overnight stays must be parked on the parking lot above the club's premises.

2. Zur Organisation der Regatta verarbeiten wir die personenbezogenen Daten, die uns die Regattateilnehmenden mit ihrer Meldung zur Regatta übermitteln. Es sind dies Name, Anschrift, E-Mail-Adresse, Verein, Bootstyp, Segelnummer und bei Regatten mit Alterswertungen der Geburtsjahrgang.

Im Rahmen der Durchführung der Regatta werden zudem Ergebnisse, rechnerische und optische Auswertungen, Positionsnachverfolgungen, auch in Form von Wettfahrtanalysen, den Teilnehmenden zugeordnet und öffentlich zugänglich gemacht, z.B. in Form von Start-/Teilnehmer- und Ergebnislisten in Aushängen an der Tafel für Bekanntmachungen, auf der Vereinshomepage www.1-scp.de und der Homepage des Segler-Verbandes Sachsen www.segeln-sachsen.de.

Im Rahmen der Durchführung und Abwicklung der Regatta werden die erforderlichen Daten insbesondere in Form von Ergebnislisten vom Verein an für uns tätige Dienstleister sowie an die zuständige Klassenvereinigung (Europe-Klassenvereinigung Geschäftsstelle, Bergstraße 5a, 24229 Schwedeneck) zur Erstellung der Rangliste und zur Auswertung und Kontrolle der Meldungen und Ergebnisse an den Deutschen Segler-Verband e.V., Gründgensstraße 18, 22309 Hamburg übermittelt. Der Deutsche Segler-Verband veröffentlicht bei Meisterschaften die Namen, Vereine und Platzierungen der besten sechs Teilnehmer/innen auf seiner Webseite. Unser Dienstleister und der DSV sind bzw. werden verpflichtet, Ihre Daten nur für die Veranstaltung und dessen Vor- und Nachbereitung einschließlich Ranglisten und übergreifender Wertungen zu verwenden. Eine kommerzielle Nutzung ist untersagt.

Im Zusammenhang mit seinem Satzungszweck (Förderung des Segelsports) veröffentlicht der Verein im Rahmen einer Berichterstattung über die Regatta personenbezogene Daten, Texte, Fotos und Filme der Regattateilnehmenden in *seinem Rundschreiben* sowie auf *seiner Homepage*, *in sozialen Medien* und übermittelt diese Daten zur Sportberichterstattung ggf. an Print- und Telemedien sowie elektronische Medien. Dies betrifft insbesondere Start-, Teilnehmer- und Ergebnislisten der Regatta. Die Veröffentlichung/Übermittlung von Daten beschränkt sich hierbei neben Fotos und Filmen auf Name, Vereinszugehörigkeit und - soweit aus sportlichen Gründen erforderlich - Alter oder Geburtsjahrgang.

3. Die Teilnehmenden können jederzeit gegenüber dem ausrichtenden Verein der Veröffentlichung von Einzelphotos ihrer Person widersprechen. Ab Zugang des Widerspruchs unterbleibt die

Veröffentlichung/Übermittlung und der Verein entfernt vorhandene Fotos von seiner Homepage und aus den sozialen Medien.

Durch ihre Meldung zur Regatta und die damit verbundene Anerkennung der Regeln und dieser Datenschutzhinweise stimmen die Regattateilnehmenden der Erhebung, Verarbeitung (Speicherung, Veränderung, Übermittlung) und Nutzung ihrer personenbezogenen Daten in dem vorgenannten Ausmaß und Umfang zu. Eine anderweitige Datenverwendung ist dem ausrichtenden Verein nur erlaubt, sofern er aus gesetzlichen Gründen hierzu verpflichtet ist. Ein Datenverkauf ist nicht statthaft.
